



How to make a Greek Temple:



Fun Fact: Columns decorated with a scroll are known as Ionic columns.

pediment

column

frieze

capital

Use adhesive foam pads to stick the frieze above the columns.

 Cut a straw to the same length as your frieze and use glue to stick it above the frieze.

11. Draw a triangle on the thick white card to form the **pediment** of your temple. The length of this triangle needs to be the same length as your frieze and it should be approximately 5cm in height. Then, cut it out. The pediment contained

sculptures so why not decorate your own pediment with pictures of ancient Greek gods or goddesses?
