Can you create a fact file about an arctic animals? Find three animals that live in an arctic

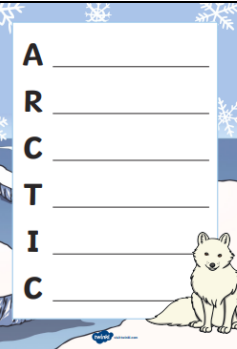


environment and research their habitat, food, adaptations and one fun fact.

Design a flag for an arctic expedition team. Include symbols on your flag that reflect the team's values or mission.

Extension- can you write an explanation of why you have chosen your symbols?

Write an arctic themed poem. You can choose the style: haiku, rhyming, acrostic etc. Illustrate your poem with some arctic pictures.

Create a podcast explaining documenting an explorers first time stepping foot in the Antarctic. Think about sound effects you could use to make your podcast more interesting.

Build a model of an Arctic Base camp using recycled materials. As an extension you could add a fact sheet to explain how each part of your model will keep your explorers warm.

Please read at least **5 or 6 times a week** to an adult and fill in your Reading Record Book. We will monitor this at school.

Design and make your own Arctic Explorers survival kit. Think about clothes, equipment and food you could take with you. You could also draw a poster of your ideas and label it to explain why you have made your choices.



Can you research some geographical facts about the continent of Antarctica? Does it have a capital city? Does it have a Prime Minister or a President? What is the climate like?

What animals are adapted to live there? Present your findings in a fact file.



Create a diary entry from the point of view of an arctic explorer experiencing your first day in the Arctic.
