Nursery and Childcare from age 2-11 years

Gateway Lodge Nursery is situated in the grounds of Lea Primary School, in a purpose built lodge, surrounded by beautiful countryside. The children experience a homefrom-home environment, with an open plan feel.

We provide high-quality childcare and pride ourselves on our experienced, highly qualified nursery staff, as well as our well-resourced indoor and outdoor spaces.



Gateway Lodge Nursery links up with the school to provide term time childcare, from 7.45am to 5.30pm, for children from the age of 2 years old.

We offer funded places to 2, 3 and 4 year olds, of between 15 and 30 hours per week. Spaces are limited to ensure all children can be cared for and nurtured individually. We give children time and comfort, to support their emotional development, as well as offering exciting learning opportunities for all ages.
