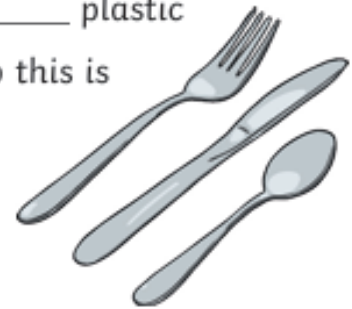
Ocean Plastics
