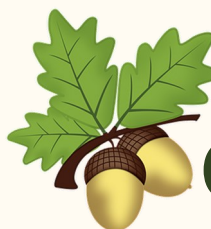

A huge thank you to all who supported, donated & attended our Easter Bingo on Tuesday.

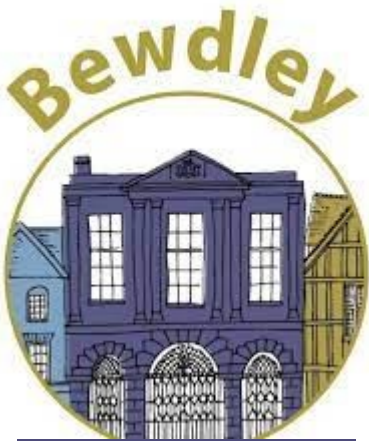
These events could not be a success without the kind donations from parents & pupils. Thank you also, to Lea Village Stores for their egg donation.

Museum

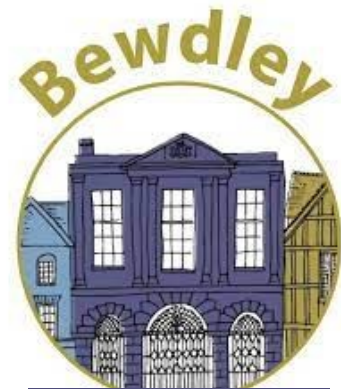
On Tuesday, Oak class went on our class trip to Bewdley Museum for a fun, fact-filled day learning all about what it would be like to be an evacuee during World War 2.

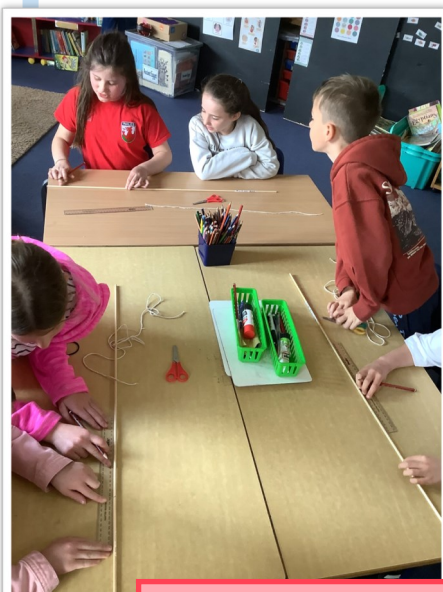


Afterwards, we had a lovely picnic lunch in the sunshine at the station.

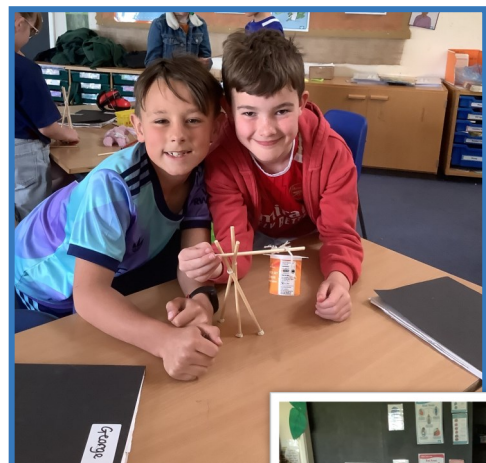

Thank you to our amazing parent/ grandparent volunteers, who accompanied us; we really appreciate your support.

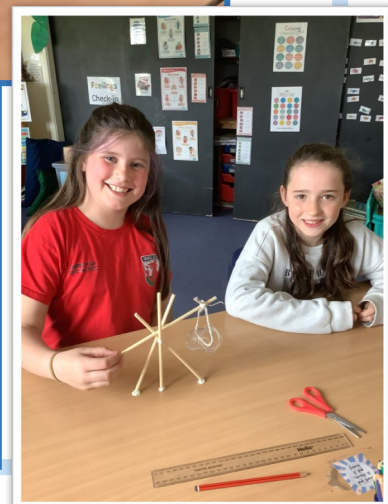
Rowan class have recently been enjoying some creative activities in their science and their DT topics of 'Sound' and of 'Ancient Egypt'.

Mrs Griffiths and Mrs James cooked them for us to eat with our roast dinner!



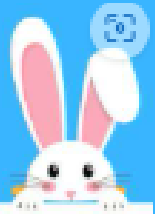
